


Geography Marking Targets













KUS	Knowledge, understanding and structure
T1	I need to recap on the content of my lessons, so I have more points to discuss to answer the question
T2	I know most of the points but need to start expanding more to show my depth of understanding
Т3	I need to use examples when I can to support my work.
Т4	When assessing, discussing and evaluating I need to consider both sides of the argument
Т5	I need to ensure the points I make help answer the question.
Т6	Ensure to bring points into context - don't just immediately move from one point to another
HLT	Higher level targets
Т7	I need to differentiate my points: social, economic and environmental effects for example
Т8	I need to consider different spatial scales, for example, local, national and global
Т9	I need to consider different temporal scales (time scales) for example, short term and long term effects/primary and secondary effects
T10	I need to think about the question in more depth and consider all my knowledge: retrieve information and think holistically
L	Literacy
T11	I need to ensure that I am using capital letters for the start of sentences and for names. I need to use full stops to end my sentences
T12	I need to aim to use more tier 2 and tier 3 vocabulary
T13	I need to write in paragraphs to structure my points
EA	Effort/Attendance
T14	I need to put more effort in to my lessons and home learning to give myself a better chance of tackling the questions
