After half term, in line with our commitment to inclusion, Shrewsbury Academy is proud to announce the opening of our assessment centre: The Lighthouse. This will be a purpose designed provision to offer an adapted curriculum to a small number of students who experience barriers in accessing our broader curriculum offer.

The Lighthouse will offer an alternative environment and curriculum designed to support students in building a sense of belonging and supporting student potential, as we do for all of our students.

The Lighthouse curriculum will be based upon literacy, numeracy and project based learning to engage students with quality teaching and learning.

Some students who currently access our SEND hub provision may experience some changes to the locations of their support. We are confident the changes ahead will lead to more students accessing the provision they require to build engagement and success in learning.
